Term 4 Swimming for Sport –5 x Fridays only 2 -30 Nov

Term 4 sport will be water confidence, stroke correction and fun at the Orange Ex-services club indoor heated pool. Notes have gone home and cost is \$20 per child. The P&C will be covering the bus cost.

All children are required to have the permission note signed & \$20 paid and returned to school before next Friday, otherwise they cannot swim. Please contact the office if you don't have a note.

The children can wear swimmers under their uniform to school as we leave at 10.15am, but please make sure they have **underwear towel and goggles** if required in their water proof bag.

This will start Friday 2 November and finish Friday 30 November.

Term 4 Intensive Swimming Program -Mon- Fri 3-14 Dec

Starting Monday 3 December, we will commence our intensive 2 week swimming program, where children will be grouped according to swimming level and taught a range of safety skills as well as stroke improvement.

Notes have gone home and cost again is \$20 per child with the P&C paying for bus. Please make sure notes and money are returned to school prior to this or NO Swimming.

The children can wear swimmers under their uniform to school as we leave at 10.00am, but please make sure they have **underwear towel and goggles** if required in their water proof bag.
